Students will study languages in their theoretical and practical aspects; fiction and oral folk art; various types of texts; oral, written and virtual communication.*

- *teach using their knowledge of the system of modern Russian literary language and active processes, knowledge of the methodology of teaching Russian as a foreign language and creating tests, modern digital technologies*
- *conduct research based on their knowledge of the conceptual apparatus of philology, methods of collection and analysis of linguistic material, methods of empirical research in the field of the theory and practice of teaching Russian as a foreign language*
